Injury Vehicle Collision: On April 19, 2023, at 9:41 am, officers were dispatched to a collision that occurred near Pheasant Dr. and Partridge Dr. The vehicle drove through the intersection and into the parking lot of Happy Harvard Pre-School. The vehicle hit a fire hydrant, went over the embankment and down the hillside, and landed on its roof. The 64 year old male driver, of El Sobrante, was trapped in the vehicle. He appeared to have sustained multiple injuries. The driver was transported to a Trauma Center via Air Ambulance. Both front tires were missing from the vehicle. The front passenger side tire was located in the 1700 block of Pheasant, The vehicle collided with a car, parked in front of a residence, and left the front wheel, brake assembly, and control arm at the location. The vehicle continued down Pheasant colliding with the fire hydrant, ultimately coming to rest on its roof after traveling approximately 100 feet through the air. The whereabouts of his front driver's side rim and tire are unknown. As of 9:00am, today, the injured driver was listed as in serious but stable condition. There was no indication of alcohol being involved, however the collision is still under investigation. **H23-00398**
