Warrant Arrest: On May 9, 2023, at approximately 9:09 AM, an Officer conducted a vehicle check on a Silver Toyota Highlander, in the parking lot of Burger King. A 28 year old female, of Yuba City, was found to have an outstanding, non-citable, warrant from Sutter County. The subject was arrested and booked at the Martinez Detention Facility. **Case 23-00474**

Occupied Stolen Vehicle/Poss. Controlled Substance/Possession of Burglary Tools: On May 9, 2023, at approximately 10:42 AM, Investigators were conducting follow-up in the 600 block of 26th Street, in Richmond. to obtain a statement from a subject who was arrested, by our agency, for Auto Theft. The Detectives located the 39 year old female, they wanted to interview, seated in a Toyota Truck. The truck was parked in the 600 block of 26th Street. The attached license plate returned to a 2007 Chevrolet. A record check of the VIN, on the 1992 Toyota, revealed it was an outstanding stolen vehicle reported to Richmond PD on March 22, 2023. The plate attached was seized. The female was placed under arrest for Possession of a Stolen Vehicle. A search of the vehicle revealed a substance, suspected Methamphetamine. Officers also found multiple shaved keys. One of the shaved keys was being used in the ignition. The subject was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility on various charges. The owner of the Toyota truck was contacted and picked up their vehicle. **Case- 23-00475/476**

Recovered Lost/Stolen License Plate: On May 9, 2023, at approximately 2:19 PM, Officers received a Flock notification for a Lost/Stolen license plate attached to a Silver 2007 Ford F-150. The license plate belonged to a 2017 Grey F-150. A traffic stop was conducted on the F-150 Eastbound I-80 at Willow Ave off-ramp. A record check of the F-150's VIN revealed the vehicle was clear of wants. The owner stated his f-150 had been stolen last year in Vallejo and when the truck was returned to him, the license plate was attached and was never removed. The license plates were collected. **Case 23-00447**

Mental Health Evaluation: On May 9, 2023, at approximately 3:00 PM, Officers were dispatched to a family disturbance in the 200 block of Bobolink Way. The reporting party stated her 15 year old son, was acting out and punching holes in the wall. Officers arrived on scene and determined the juvenile to be a danger to himself and others. The juvenile was transported to the County Regional Medical Center to be evaluated by mental health professionals. **Case 23-00448**
