Mental Health Evaluation: On May 10, 2023, at approximately 7:16 AM, Officers were disaptched to the 200 block of Grenadine Way for a report of an out of control 13 year old male juvenile (JUV). The Reprting Party (RP) stated JUV had left the house on foot, towards Hannah Ranch. Officers located JUV at the soccer fields in Hannah Ranch. Based on speaking with the RP, JUV's father, and JUV, he was determined to be a danger to others. JUV was taken to the County Regional Medical Center to be evaluated by mental health professionals.
