**Towed Vehicle:** On May 15, 2023, at approximately 12:04 PM, an Officer located a 1996 Chevrolet Silverado in the Home Depot parking lot. The Silverado's registration expired in March of 2022. The Silverado was towed for the registration violation. **Case 23-00503**

**Occupied Stolen Vehicle:** On May 15, 2023, at approximately 1:22 PM, Officers received a Flock notification for a stolen 2022 Toyota Camry, reported out of Fairfield PD on May 15, 2023, traveling southbound on Willow Ave at Sycamore Ave. An Officer located the Toyota at Shell, while the driver was pumping gas at a gas pump. The Toyota was blocked in, and a traffic stop was conducted. The 49 year old male driver, of Vallejo, and a 44 year old female passenger, of Richmond, were detained. The investigation revealed the driver believed the Toyota (a rental vehicle) was not due back until today, however the vehicle was due back yesterday and subsequently reported stolen, today, by the rental car company. Both subjects were released on scene pending further investigation. The vehicle was towed and removed from the Stolen Vehicle System. **Case 23-00507**

**Fugitive from Justice Arrest:** On May 15, 2023, at approximately 3:34 PM, an Officer checked on a black Jaguar, parked in front of Big Lots. The registered owner was found to have an outstanding, fully extraditable, fraud warrant out of Austin County Sheriff's Office in Texas. Officers located the 28 year old male, of Oakland, walking out of Big Lots. The subject was detained, and the warrant was confirmed. The subject was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility. **Case 23-00508**

**Battery/ Elderly Abuse:** On May 15, 2023, at approximately 5:36 PM, Officers were dispatched to the Home Depot parking lot for a report of a physical fight between two males. Officers arrived on scene and contacted a 57 year old male, and a 45 year old male. Officers learned that the younger subject was the primary aggressor (suspect). The suspect physically assaulted the younger male (victim), who is a dependent adult with physical limitations. The suspect is the victim's caretaker. The suspect was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility. The victim declined medical aid and was picked up by a friend. Adult Protective Services was notified. **Case 23-00509**

**Mental Health Detention:** On May 15, 2023, at 7:22pm, officers were dispatched to the Franklin Canyon Golf Course parking lot for a male juvenile having a mental health crisis and attempting to walk onto the freeway. Upon arrival officers were able to detain the juvenile without incident. The juvenile expressed a desire to harm himself during the interview. Based on the subject's statements and actions he was subsequently determined to be a danger to himself. AMR responded and transported the juvenile to the County Regional Medical Center. **H23-510.**
