Domestic Violence, Robbery, Assault with Deadly Weapon, Felony Evading: On May 31, 2023 at 12:34 pm, Officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Paradise Dr. for a male physically fighting with a female. Officers were further advised the male was physically holding the female down, on the ground; then he got int a Black jeep and was attempting to leave the area. Officers arrived and located the Jeep as it was attempting to turn onto San Pablo Ave. Officers attempted to stop the vehicle by blocking it in and deploying a spike strip. However, the vehicle was able to drive around the front patrol vehicle. The passenger side rear tire was spiked as the vehicle fled the scene. The vehicle fled onto westbound 80. A pursuit was initiated, as there was a passenger in the front passenger seat and officers were concerned the passenger could be the victim, and she had not been contacted. The pursuit was initially around 50 miles per hour and traffic on the freeway was light. The suspect vehicle tire started losing pieces of the tire as it drove westbound on the freeway. The suspect exited at Richmond Parkway and continued on Blume to Hilltop, where the Jeep lost the rear passenger side tire. The Jeep reentered westbound 80 and then increased speeds to approximately 100 miles per hour, with no rear tire. Detectives made contact at the apartment complex and were able to contact the victim. The pursuit was terminated as soon as it was known the victim was safe, and not in the car. The suspect vehicle was last seen passing Carlson Blvd. The 34 year old female victim identified the suspect as a 39 year old male The suspect took the victim's cell phone, by force, and attempted to run her over as he was fleeing the apartment complex.
