Death Investigation: On June 5, 2023, at approximately 4 :38 PM, Officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Paradise Dr. The reporting party stated they found their 42 year old son deceased. Officers arrived a determined the subject was deceased. There were no indication of foul play. The Contra Costa County Coroner was called to take custody of the subject' body. **Case 23-00581**

Mental Health Evaluation: On June 6, 2023, at 3:02 am, an officer conducted a check on a vehicle. The vehicle was observed driving erratically before parking in the lot of Valley Bible Church. The Officer contacted the 30 year old male driver, of Rancho Cordova. The subject stated he was having issues and thought he needed to talk to a therapist. Due to his erratic driving and statements, the subject was determined to be a danger to himself. A search of the subject's person, prior to AMR transport, revealed a small amount of suspected methamphetamine located inside a cigarette box. The subject was transported to the County Regional Medical Center without incident. His vehicle was left secured and legally parked, and the suspected methamphetamine was taken for destruction. **H23-00582.**
