<u>Vehicle Collision with Minor Injury:</u> On June 6, 2023, at 7:01 pm, officers responded for a vehicle collision with unknown injuries near the intersection of Sycamore and San Pablo Ave. The collision was determined to be at the entrance to the parking lot located at 3600 San Pablo Ave. The 18 year old female driver of a silver Mazda collided with a silver Honda driven by a 59 year old male while turning into the parking lot and the Honda was exiting. Fire and Medics responded to the scene for extrication and transported the male driver for complaint of pain. The female driver, who also complained of pain, declined transport, and was later taken to the hospital by her mother. **Carrying Firearm in Public:** On June 7, 2023, at 1:32 am, officers responded to the Exchange Apartment building located at 2525 Bayfront for a second noise complaint after an altercation earlier in the evening.
