Theft of a Firearm: On June 12, 2023, at approximately 6:51 AM, an Officer was dispatched to the 2500 block of Bayfront Blvd for a report of a vehicle break in where a firearm was taken. The Officer arrived and contacted the victim (V), 49 year old male, who stated he parked his Tesla in the under ground parking garage. V stated he did not lock his Tesla, and left his pistol in the case in the rear trunk area of his SUV. V stated it was not loaded and did not have ammunition with it. V does not have any idea who could have taken it. The firearm was entered into AFS. The investigation is ongoing. **H23-00603**

Death Investigation/ Overdose: On June 12, 2023, at approximately 7:44 AM, Officers received a call stating that a female was possibly overdosing in a gold car parked at Safeway. Officers responded to the area and located a gold GMC Yukon parked on Sycamore Ave just past San Pablo Ave. A 37 year old male subject (SUB 1) and 40 year old female subject (SUB 2) were on scene. SUB 1 stated him and SUB 2 had been hanging out and fell asleep earlier in the day. SUB 1 woke up and started driving around. SUB 1 realized SUB 2 was not waking up and believed she was overdosing. SUB 1 stopped at the above location and waited for emergency services. SUB 2 was pronounced deceased on scene after multiple naran applications. CCSO Coroners responded to the scene and took the body for investigation. **H23-00604**

Stolen Vehicle: On June 12, 2023, at approximately 9:08 AM, an Officer responded to the 1000 block of Park Street for a report of a vehicle that had been stolen, possibly last night. The Officer responded and contacted the 62 year old male victim (V). V stated he last saw his gray Hyundai Elantra last night at approximately 7:30 PM. V has the keys to the vehicle and does not know who could've stolen it. The Hyundai had no recent Flock activations. The Hyundai was entered into SVS. **H23-00605**

Warrant Arrest: On June 12, 2023, at 11:30 PM, an officer conducted a traffic enforcement stop on a vehicle in the 1500 block of Sycamore Ave. A records check on the driver, 45 year old female of Hayward, revealed she had an outstanding warrant for her arrest out of Alameda County. The subject was arrested and booked at Martinez Detention Facility without incident and the vehicle was picked up by a family member. **H23-00606.**

Outside Assist: On June 12, 2023, at approximately 4:30 AM, an officer was notified by a CCSO Deputy of a missing juvenile from Rodeo who was picked up by her boyfriend in his mother's Honda Civic, which he did not have permission to take. A check on the provided vehicle information on FLOCK revealed its license plate was last captured in Hercules, traveling SB San Pablo Ave at Victoria Crescent West. The officer located the vehicle turning WB on Sycamore from San Pablo Ave and caught up to it. The driver of the vehicle attempted to evade prior to the officer initiating the stop by turning off its lights and quickly turning on to S. Front St. The officer was able to catch up to the vehicle and initiate a traffic stop which yielded on the 2000 block of De Anza St. The occupants of the vehicle were

detained and the keys to the vehicle were taken. CCSO was notified and responded to the scene to conduct their investigation. **Inc # 2306130056**
