**Located of a Unoccupied Stolen Vehicle:** On July 11, 2023, at approximately 7:39 AM, an Officer was dispatched to check on a suspicious 2008 Ford Escape, parked, blocking the fire/EBMUD road on Sycamore Ave near Claeys Lane. The Officer observed the vehicle had a cut up interior and flattened tires. The registered owner of the vehicle was unable to be contacted at but later called and said he last saw the vehicle parked in the 100 block of Columbine Dr. The registered owner has the keys accounted for and does not know who would have taken the vehicle. The vehicle was entered, and taken out, of the Stolen Vehicle System. **Case 23-00698**

**Death Investigation/ Firearm's Located:** On July 11, 2023, at approximately 12:28 PM, Officers were dispatched to 1375 Sycamore Ave (Aventine Apartments) for a welfare check. The reporting party stated her mother was staying there, and the daughter had been unable to reach her. The daughter got the lease holder to authorize a lock smith to open the apartment. The daughter located her 48 year old mother, apparently deceased in the bathroom. Fire and EMS were dispatched and pronounced the subject deceased. The daughter did not have medical information for the mother and the coroner took custody of the deceased. **Case 23-00699**

**Miscellaneous. Information:** On July 11, 2023, at 10:42 pm, officers responded to the Jack in the Box, located at 3800 San Pablo Ave, for a report of a runaway juvenile. The reporting party, of Rodeo, reported her 14-year-old daughter ran off, toward the train tracks behind Jack in the box, after an argument.
