Mental Health Evaluation: On July 26th, 2023 at 11:19 AM Hercules Officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Paradise for a report of a suicidal woman destroying objects in the apartment and threatening bodily harm to her mother. Officers arrived on scene and contacted the Reporting Party (RP), 43 year old female, who advised her daughter had threatened to harm herself and was in a highly agitated state. Parties were separated and officers observed the apartment was in a state of disarray which supported RP's statement that her 21 year old daughter was having a manic episode. The subject (SUB) was not compliant with officers and attempted to flee and resist detention. Officers overcame SUB's active resistance and detained her in handcuffs. SUB's aunt and RP both reported to officers they had heard SUB state she was going to harm herself. Based on family statements, officer observations of the damaged apartment, SUB's resistance and highly agitated demeanor SUB was found to be a danger to herself. SUB was placed on a mental health evaluation hold. **H23-00745**

Mental Health Evaluation: On July 26th, 2023 at 3:13 PM, officers were dispatched to a lobby detail regarding threatening statements. Officers contacted the Reporting Party (RP) who advised her 31 year old daughter has been harming herself. When RP spoke to the subject (SUB) about her behavior, SUB threatened to harm her mother. SUB barricaded herself in the home and locked all the doors and windows to the house. Officers arrived on scene and attempted to speak with SUB. SUB refused to open the door to her mother or Hercules officers. An unlocked door was eventually located, and officers made entry. SUB attempted to flee and resist officers but was unsuccessful. SUB was detained without incident and transported to the County Regional Medical Center after being determined to be a danger to herself and others. **H23-00747**
