Towed Vehicle: On August 21, 2023, at approximately 8:43 AM, an Officer conducted a traffic enforcement stop on a gold 2004 Ford Taurus wagon with a no record license plate. Officers contacted a 26 year old male of Rodeo. The subject had a suspended driver's license. The Taurus was towed for registration violations. **H23-00843**

Possession of loaded firearm, Drugs, and Paraphernalia: On August 21, 2023, at 7:20 PM, an officer checked on a suspicious vehicle with expired registration in the Home Depot Parking Lot. Upon contacting the driver, 29 year old male out of San Pablo, the officer observed drug paraphernalia in plain view. When questioned about the paraphernalia, The subject (SUB) handed the officer a small bag containing suspected methamphetamine. SUB was detained without incident. Further search of the vehicle revealed additional suspected methamphetamine, and a handgun, concealed under the driver's seat. A records check on the firearm revealed SUB was not the registered owner. SUB was booked at Martinez Detention Facility without incident and the vehicle was towed. **H23-00844**

Domestic Violence: On August 22, 2023, at 12:16 AM, officers responded to the 100 block of Maple Ct. for a report of a domestic battery. The Reporting Party (RP), 37 year old female, stated her 38 year old husband kicked her during an argument. Both parties were separated without incident and the RP declined medical attention. After further investigation, it was determined the RP was the dominant aggressor. During a verbal argument, she hit her husband with a closed fist. The RP was arrested without incident and the husband was admonished for his actions. The husband declined medical aid, prosecution, and an Emergency Protective Order. **H23-00845**
