Theft of a Package, Delaying and Obstructing: On September 25, 2023, at 11:05 am, Officers were dispatched to the area of San Pablo Ave and John Muir Pkwy for a suspicious circumstance. Dispatch advised a passerby observed a subject with a shopping cart going through a UPS drop box. An Officer located a subject matching the description near the drop box. The subject was identified as a 27 year old female. The subject (SUB) was found to be in possession of a UPS package that was not addressed to/from her. Further inspection of the drop box revealed a similar package inside the box, wedged inside the drop box's delivery door and main container. The package appeared like someone attempted to forcefully remove it from the box but was unsuccessful. As SUB was being detained, she resisted Officers by pulling her arms away several times as the Officers grabbed them to detain her in handcuffs. In addition, SUB refused to provide Officers with her date of birth after being asked several times during a lawful detention. At the conclusion of the investigation, SUB was placed under arrest for package theft and delaying and obstructing Officers. She was issued a citation for the violations and released at the scene on her signed promise to appear. **H23-00980**

Strong Arm Robbery: On September 25, 2023, at 4:27 pm, an Officer was flagged down at the Safeway gas station. The Reporting Party/Victim, 52 year old female, told the Officer she had just been robbed. RP/V had been refueling when two suspects in a black Honda Accord pulled up and parked beside her vehicle. While RP/V was pumping gas an adult male exited the Honda. The suspect then walked up to the front passenger door of RP/V's vehicle, opened it, and removed her bag from the front passenger seat. RP/V ran around her vehicle to retrieve her bag from the suspect. A brief struggle ensued at which time RP/V was forcefully pushed down to the ground and her bag was ripped from her hands. The suspect then got back into the front passenger seat of the Honda which immediately fled the scene. **H23-00982**
