Warrant Arrest: On October 3, 2023, at 8:48 am, an Officer contacted a 19 year old female, in front of her home. The subject was found to have an active, no cite, warrant held by Hercules PD. The warrant was issued on September 29, 2023. The subject was taken into custody and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility. <u>H23-01009</u>

Lost Property: On October 3, 2023, at 10:11 am, an Officer handled a lobby detail regarding a lost license plate. The reporting party stated she was involved in a non-injury collision, in Hercules, on October 2, 2023. During the collision, the front of her vehicle collided with another vehicle. The reporting party believes her front license plate was knocked off at that time, but she was unaware of it on the day of the collision. She returned to the collision scene upon discovering her front license plate was gone but was unsuccessful in locating it. <u>H23-01010</u>

Miscellaneous: On October 3, 2023, at 1:16 pm, Officers were dispatched to the 1200 block of Willow Ave for the report of someone trying to run the reporting party off the road. While enroute, the reporting party drove away from the scene, and intercepted Officers in the area of Sycamore Ave at Lupine Rd. Upon further investigation, it was determined that a physical altercation occurred at an apartment in the 1200 block of Willow Ave The parties involved were two 18 year old females, a 19 year old female, and a 21 year old male. The altercation stemmed from an argument which turned physical when the three females engaged in brief mutual combat. None of the involved parties desired prosecution. A report was taken to document the incident. At the conclusion of the incident, a civil standby was conducted so one of the females could gather her belongings and move out of the apartment. **H23-01011**

Vehicle Collision: On October 3, 2023, at 5:30 pm, Officers were dispatched to the area of San Pablo Ave and John Muir Pkwy for the report of a vehicle collision with an overturned vehicle. Officers located an overturned 2016 silver Honda HRV at the intersection of John Muir Pkwy and San Pablo Ave. It was determined the 18 year old female driver was driving southbound on San Pablo Ave. Upon reaching the intersection, a red SUV reportedly cut in front of her, causing her to veer the Honda to the right to avoid a collision. The maneuver resulted in the driver crashing her Honda into a curb, causing the Honda to turnover onto its roof.
