**Theft from an unlocked Vehicle:** On October 5, 2023, at 9:06 am, an officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Caprice Cir for a theft report. The victim stated that sometime over night by an unknown suspect who opened the doors on his vehicle and took his wallet. **H23-01013**

**Tampering with a Vehicle:** On October 5, 2023, at 11:26 am officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Midship for a vehicle that was entered into sometime over night, but nothing was stolen. **H23-01014**

**Theft of Jewelry:** On October 5, 2023, at 1:51pm, an officer was dispatched to a lobby detail regarding a theft that occurred in September 2023. The victim stated she had workers in her home at the beginning of September. She noticed, sometime near the end of September, some of her jewelry was missing from her Jewelry box. **H23-01015**

**Missing Juvenile Locate:** On October 5, at 9:48 PM HPD Officers were dispatched to the area of Bobolink Way/Hawk Ct for a 14 year old male juvenile who was lost. Upon arrival, HPD Officers determined the subject was not lost, but instead needed a ride back to his group home, at the Alameda County Assessment Center, located in Hayward. A Records check determined the subject was reported missing from Riverside CO SO and Hayward PD. Children and Family Services was notified and HPD transported the subject back to his group home. The subject was removed from Missing and Unidentified Persons System. **H23-01016**

**Outside Assist:** On October 5, at 9:22 PM Pinole PD Officers responded to Pinole High School for a reported fight between two families. Pinole PD arrived, and multiple subjects ran. Per witnesses, a firearm was brandished. Hercules PD, CCCSO, and Star 3 responded to assist with a perimeter. After an extensive search, no firearm was located. **H23-01017**

**Stolen Vehicle:** On October 6, 2023, at 1:23 pm, an officer was dispatched to Safeway for a stolen vehicle report. The victim stated that an unknown suspect stole his 2004 Black Chevrolet Suburban. The vehicle hit the Flock camera, on Willow at Cambridge, at 12:42pm. **H23-01018**

**Mental Health Evaluation:** On October 6, 2023, at 3:04 pm, officers were dispatched to Ohlone Elementary School for a student who wanted to hurt themself. Officers contacted the student who confirmed wanting to hurt themself. The student was determined to be a danger to themself and was transported to Contra Costa County Regional Medical Center, by AMR. **H23-01019**

**Recovered Stolen Vehicle:** On October 6, 2023, at 12:26 pm, officers were dispatched to the area of San Pablo Ave and Tsushima St. for a vehicle that was on the Railroad Tracks, there was also a female seen walking away from the vehicle towards Pinole. The Chevy Silverado was approximately 30 feet away from the tracks stuck in the dirt. The female was

not located after an area check. The registered owner of the truck was contacted, and it was determined to be an outstanding unreported stolen vehicle. The Victim called Concord PD to make a stolen vehicle report then responded to the scene to take possession of his truck.

**Occupied Stolen Vehicle:** On October 6 at 2348 hours, an HPD Officer conducted a traffic stop on a Silver BMW with no plates at Turquoise Dr/Crystal Cir. A Records check of the VIN determined the BMW was reported stolen to Elk Grove PD on October 5, 2023. Th 34 year old female driver was detained without incident. The subject stated the owner of the vehicle gave her the BMW. The owner was contacted and stated he didn't desire prosecution. The subject was released pending further investigation. **H23-1021**

**Possession of Controlled Substance:** On October 7, 7:54 PM HPD Officers were flagged down at Home Depot for a shoplifter inside the store. HPD Officers located a 36 year old male and conducted a search. Officers located a plastic bag containing suspected methamphetamine. The subject was arrested for possession of methamphetamine. **Recovered Stolen Vehicle:** On October 7, 10:48 PM HPD Officers received a FLOCK hit on a stolen 2001 Chevrolet Silverado in the area of Sycamore Ave/Palm Ave. An Officer located the Chevrolet unoccupied in the 500 block of Silver Maple Dr. Officers searched the area and were unable to locate the suspect. The Chevrolet was towed from the scene and removed from the Stolen Vehicle System. **H23-01023**

**Recovered Stolen Vehicle:** On October 8, 2023, at 3:27 pm, Officers were requested to respond to Claeys Ranch (100 Claeys Ln) for the report of a white Chevy pickup truck that was found abandoned on the property. Officers observed the vehicle crashed through one of the property's fences and into a hillside. The truck sustained front and rear damage and the airbag was deployed. No one was located inside the vehicle. A Records check of the vehicle listed a Hercules resident as the registered owner. An Officer responded to the registered owner's residence, and determined the Chevy was an unreported stolen vehicle. Surveillance camera footage indicated the Chevy had been stolen, from the front of the victim's home, by an unknown suspect. The theft occurred sometime after 9:00 pm yesterday evening. The registered owner is away from the home, but a family member took possession of the vehicle. No one at the home was aware the Chevy was gone until they were contacted by HPD. **H23-01024**

**Stolen Vehicle:** On October 8, 2023, at 4:47 pm, an Officer was dispatched to the 3000 block of N Front St. for the report of a stolen vehicle. The victim stated that sometime today, between approximately :1:00 and 1:15pm, an unknown suspect stole his 2000 Ford F-250 Super Duty pickup truck from the front of his home. **H23-01025**

**Outside Assist:** On October 8<sup>th</sup>, 2023 at 8:10 PM, officers were dispatched to Valley Bible for a report of a rollover vehicle collision. The reporting party advised the vehicle which was a 2018 gray Ford Taurus had crashed into the church and was on fire. The driver of the vehicle was reported to be trapped inside. Officers arrived on scene and were able to force open the passenger side door and extract the driver and his dog. The 54 year old male driver sustained minor injuries and was transported via ambulance to a local hospital The dog was uninjured. It was determined the driver lost control of his vehicle on Highway 4 and inadvertently struck a Dodge Challenger. The driver proceeded, in his vehicle, and drove through the fence which runs parallel to Highway 4. The driver struck a church bus and finally

came to rest and overturned his vehicle in the Valley Bible parking lot. CHP was notified and responded to the scene to take a collision report. The driver of the Challenger was on scene and CHP obtained his statement. The dog was given to animal control and the vehicle was towed from the scene. **H23-1026**

**Vehicle VS Skateboarder:** On October 8<sup>th</sup>, 2023 at 10:02 PM, officers were dispatched to a pedestrian who had been struck by a vehicle on Sycamore Avenue at Turquoise. Officers arrived on scene and began to render aid to a 57 year old male who was laying injured in the roadway. The subject was struck by a passing vehicle as he rode his skateboard in the street. The subject suffered major cuts, abrasions, and was bleeding heavily from his mouth and head. AMR responded to the scene and transported the subject to a local hospital. A statement was obtained from the 59 year old male driver of the 2007 white Chevrolet Avalanche, inadvertently struck the skateboarder as he rode his skateboard in the street **H23-1027**
