Driving Under the Influence: On October 16, 2023 at 10:51 PM an officer observed a gray 1999 Honda Civic parked at the 76 gas station. A 26 year old male was exiting the gas station building, stumbling and walking unsteadily. The subject entered the Honda and drove out of the gas station lot. The officer conducted a traffic stop for various vehicle code violations and to conduct a DUI investigation. The Honda began to merge onto I80 East bound. The vehicle yielded on the 80 east on ramp from Willow Avenue. The officer contacted the subject who had a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from his person. Several empty beer cans were observed on the passenger side floorboards. The subject was given the Standard Field Sobriety Test; and the Preliminary Alcohol Screening device indicated he was over the presumptive limit for the purposes of driving. The subject was placed under arrest. The subject was transported back to Hercules PD for a blood draw. He was later released to a a responsible party. <u>H23-1039</u>

<u>Attempt Recovery of a Stolen Vehicle:</u> On October 17, 2023 at 3:01 AM Hercules officers received a FLOCK notification of a stolen 2014 Jeep grand Cherokee traveling South on Willow Avenue towards Shell gas station.
