Possession of Metal Knuckles: On October 17, 2023 at 10:45 PM officers were dispatched to a call regarding a male riding around on an electric bicycle with a white strobe light attempting stop passing cars near the Aventine apartments on Sycamore Avenue. Officers contacted a 36 year old male. The subject advised he was in possession of brass knuckles which he carries for self-defense. The subject was detained and arrested, without incident, and the knuckles were seized as evidence. A search incident to arrest revealed the subject was in possession of several articles of mail from multiple addresses in Hercules. The mail was seized and returned to its rightful owners. The subject was cited, for the brass knuckles, and released on scene. He was given a courtesy transport home.
