Officers arrived on scene with fire and found rigor mortis already setting in. The subject, 55 year old male, was pronounced deceased at 7:03 am, due to natural causes. Recovered Stolen Vehicle: On October 18, 2023, at 8:51 am officers were notified of a stolen vehicle on Willow Avenue near Cambridge. Officers located the vehicle traveling on State Route 4 West bound and then it got onto Westbound Interstate 80. The officer initiated a traffic enforcement stop and the vehicle yielded just prior to the Pinole Valley Road off ramp. A felony stop was done on the 2023 Toyota 4Runner. The driver, 31 year old male subject (SUB 1) out of Oakland, was later released and the passenger, 21 year old male subject (SUB 2) out of North Carolina, was arrested for stealing the vehicle and being in possession of the stolen vehicle. He was also arrested for identity theft and using false information to impersonate another person. Officers also located a large amount of cash in a sock. The Contra Costa County District Attorney's office was contacted, and the cash was taken as evidence. The vehicle was towed and SUB 2 was transported to Martinez Detention Facility. <u>H23-01042</u>
