It was determined he drove away from his home in the morning. Officers located the subject, in his black Lexus SUV, parked in the Starbucks parking lot on Pinole Valley Road. The subject displayed symptoms of needing medical care. He was transported to a local hospital Kaiser. **H23-01078**

**Outside Assist** On November 02, 2023 at 12:13 AM officers responded to the 2800 block of Estates Avenue, in Pinole, for a combative 36 year old male. Hercules officers assisted Pinole officers in restraining the subject. Pinole PD handled the arrest and transport. **H23-01079**

**Death Investigation** On November 02, 2023 at 3:24 AM officers responded to the 100 block of Oneil Circle for a two year old female not responsive and not breathing. Officers contacted parents. Officer administered CPR until RHF and AMR arrived on scene. The child was unable to be revived and was pronounced deceased on scene. The Contra Costa County Coroner arrived and transported the child to the Coroner's office. **H23-01080**
