Possession of Fentanyl for Sales, Possession of Marijuana for Sales, Possession of LSD for Sales, Transportation of Controlled Substances, Possession of Controlled Substance Without Prescription, Possession of Morphine: On December 12, 2023, at 11:12 AM an officer stopped a silver Infiniti G35 for multiple vehicle code violations. The driver, 25 year old male subject (SUB 1), of El Sobrante, immediately exited the Infiniti and attempted to walk away from the scene. SUB 1 was ordered to remain seated in the vehicle and was compliant. As the officer spoke to SUB 1, he began making furtive movements in the car towards his waistband and driver's side floorboard. The officer observed a large, clear plastic bag containing dozens of pills near SUB 1's feet. The officer ordered SUB 1 to stop reaching around the vehicle but SUB 1 did not comply. SUB 1 was detained as incoming units arrived on scene. The passenger, 21 year old male subject (SUB 2), of Rodeo, was compliant throughout and was escorted out of the passenger seat without incident. Both SUB 1 and SUB 2 were detained. A probable cause search of the vehicle was conducted which yielded the recovery of suspected marijuana (split between 4 clear, plastic bags), suspected LSD, two digital scales, suspected Percocet pills, suspected Fentanyl, and suspected Morphine pills. SUB 1 was placed under arrest for a multitude of charges related to the possession of illicit substances for sales. The vehicle was towed from the scene. SUB 1 was transported to Martinez Detention Facility and his narcotics were seized as evidence. **H23-01203**

Supplement for Case 23-01196: On December 12, 2023, at approximately 6:39 PM, Officers located the wanted, 2016 Honda Accord, parked in an open garage port on Napoli Ct. The Officers executed the warrant for the vehicle, and it was towed.
