<u>Warrant Arrest:</u> On April 8, 2024, at 3:41 PM an officer observed a male walking on Sycamore Avenue near Redwood Drive. The officer knew the 37 year old male suspect and was aware of an outstanding Hercules PD warrant for his arrest. The officer detained the suspect without incident and placed him under arrest for his warrant. The suspect was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility. <u>H23-00449</u>

**Shoplifting:** On April 8, 2024, at 4:09 PM officers were dispatched to Big Lots for a theft which had just occurred. The witness advised two females had just stolen merchandise and fled in a gray 2012 Kia Sorrento. Officers located the vehicle and initiated an investigative stop. A 51 year old female subject (SUB 1) and 27 year old female subject (SUB 2) were detained without incident. An in- field show was conducted and both suspects were positively identified by a witness. SUB 1 and SUB 2 were placed under arrest and cited and released on scene. **H24-00331** 

<u>Outside Assist:</u> On April 8, 2024, at 10:04 PM, deputies heard automatic gunfire coming from the Rodeo Projects. Deputies responded and located an adult female victim on Napa Ave near Mariposa St. The victim was suffering from a non-life-threatening gunshot wound to her leg. The Contra Costa County Sheriff Office (CCCSO) requested Hercules PD to assist with crowd control and outer perimeter security. The CCCSO is handling this investigation. <u>Incident 2404080277</u>

<u>Mental Health:</u> On April 9, 2024, at 12:08 AM, officers contacted a 46 year old female, of Napa, who was loitering in the Safeway bathroom after store hours. The subject was determined to be a danger to herself and was transported to the Contra Consta County Regional Medical Center. <u>H24-00332</u>

Mental Health: On April 9, 2024, at 12:13 AM, while handling the above detail, officers were advised of a battery that occurred near Bayfront Blvd. Two adult females walked from the scene to Safeway looking for help. They were at an encampment bonfire (along the Hercules coastline) when they were allegedly assaulted by a 37 year old male subject (SUB), of Rodeo, who was intoxicated. Neither of the parties had visible injuries or wanted prosecution for the battery. SUB was located at Bayfront/Earnest and determined to be a danger to himself after witnesses said he tried to impale his chest with a dagger while at the bonfire. No crime was substantiated. SUB was transported to Contra Consta County Regional Medical Center. H24-00333
