Recovered Stolen Vehicle: On April 11, 2024, at 3:08 AM an Officer located a spray-painted U-Haul trailer around John Muir Pkwy/Tioga Loop. The trailer had U-Haul markings, but the identifying numbers were spray painted. Officers were able to locate partial identifying number and U-Haul dispatch was contacted. U-Haul was able to confirm the trailer was stolen. A courtesy report was taken for the stolen trailer. U-Haul sent out their own tow and picked up.
