Possession of Stolen Vehicle and Baton: On May 13, 2024, at 2:12 pm, an officer checked on a vehicle to the rear of Mazatlán at 828 Willow Ave. The Gray Chevy Tahoe was a “cold plated” stolen vehicle. Prior to contacting the occupants of the vehicle, a male walked away from the Tahoe leaving a 43 year old female, of Rodeo, in the vehicle. The 32 year old male, of Vallejo, was later located hiding in the women’s bathroom at Mountain Mike’s Pizza. The female was later released pending further investigation. The male was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility for possession of a stolen vehicle and possession of an expandable baton.
