Possession. Of Firearm/ Warrant Arrest: On May 23, 2024 at 9:53 PM an officer was patrolling the parking lot in the 800 block of Willow Avenue. The officer located a black Volvo SUV. A record check, on the license plate, indicated the registered owner had an active warrant. The officer contacted the occupants. They were identified as a 38 year old male, of Richmond, and a 28 year old female, pf Concord. Neither subject was the registered owner of the vehicle. However, the male had a non-citable warrant and was on searchable probation. During the search, a loaded handgun was located in a fanny pack that was in the male subject's possession. The firearm was unregistered. The male was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility. The female was released at the scene. **H24-00446**

Warrant Arrest: On May 23, 2024 at 1:46 PM an officer conducted a traffic stop on a red Chrysler 300 at 1500 Sycamore Avenue. The 40 year old male driver, from Richmond, had a non-citable warrant out of Contra Costa County. The subject was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility. **H24-00447**

Shoplifting: On May 25, 2024 at 11:59 PM officers responded to Home Depot at 1625 Sycamore Avenue for a theft in progress Home Depot employees advised the suspect was a tall adult male wearing a beige shirt, and blue jeans. The male was last seen running past Big Lots. Officers located a 32 year old male, from Sacramento, in the area. He matched the description of the suspect, and was in possession of the stolen power tools, and a Home Depot cart. The subject was detained. He was identified, by a Home Depot employee, as the suspect. The stolen property was estimated to be approximately \$600. The subject was arrested, cited, and released on scene. The items were returned to Home Depot. **H24-00449.**

Driving Under Influence (DUI): On May 25, 2024, at 11:27pm, an officer conducted a DUI investigation stop on the WB I80 on ramp near John Muir Pkwy, after observing a Silver Toyota swerving within the lane. The 30 year old male driver, of San Pablo, was given the Standard Field Sobriety Test. He refused to take a Preliminary Alcohol Screening test and was subsequently arrested. The subject was transported back to HPD for a consensual blood alcohol test. The subject was later cited, and released, to a responsible party. **H24-00450.**

Driving Under Influence (DUI): On May 26, 2024, at 10:40pm, an officer conducted a traffic stop on a white GMC pickup, at San Pablo Ave and Victoria Crescent East. Upon contact the 31 year old male driver, showed objective signs of intoxication, and had an open container of alcohol in the vehicle. The subject was given the Standard Field Sobriety Test. The Preliminary Alcohol Screening Device indicated the subject was over the presumptive limit for the purposes of driving. The subject was arrested and transported to HPD for a consensual blood alcohol test, He was cited and released to a responsible party **H24-00451.**

Shoplifting: On May 27, 2024, at 1:20 pm, officers were dispatched to Rite Aid for a theft that had just occurred. The reporting party stated an adult male, was wearing a gray shirt, and had a big bun on his head. The suspect had just stolen wine and was walking out of the parking lot towards Willow Ave. An officer located the 24 year old male suspect, out of Rodeo. The subject was detained and positively identified as the suspect. He was arrested, cited, and released on his signed promise to appear. **H24-00452**

Driving Under Influence (DUI): On May 27, 2024, at 11:14pm, an officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle at Willow and Viewpointe. The 27 year old male driver, of Benicia, showed objective signs of intoxication. The subject was also found to be on searchable probation out of Solano County. A probation search was conducted with negative results. The subject was given the Standard Field Sobriety Test. The Preliminary Alcohol Screening Device indicated the subject was over the presumptive limit for the purposes of driving. The subject was arrested and transported to HPD for a consensual blood alcohol test. He was cited and released to his mother. **H24-00453.**
