**Prisoner Transport:** On May 29th, 2024, at 10:05 AM an officer picked up and transported a 31 year old female to the Martinez Detention Facility (MDF) for booking. The subject had an outstanding warrant for a Hercules PD case. The subject was placed under arrest and booked at MDF without incident. **H24-00458**

**Miscellaneous Information Report:** On May 29th, 2024, at 10:53 AM, an officer on patrol noticed a large fire near the Willow Avenue on ramp to Highway 80 West. The fire appeared to have originated from a vehicle parked at an encampment. Fire units were requested, and the firefighters were able to extinguish the fire before any property damage occurred. Upon further examination, it was determined that a trailer, which had been left at the encampment, had somehow caught fire, and was destroyed by the flames. The VIN and license plate were unreadable, and an owner was not able to be determined. **H24-00459**

**Non-Injury Collision:** On May 29th, 2024, at 10:30 AM an officer was dispatched to a non-injury collision which occurred on Willow Avenue near the 76-gas station. Party 1 (P1), 54 year old female, inadvertently collided her white 1999 Lexus ES300 into Party 2 (P2), 59 year old female, as she was driving her black 2018 Jeep Compass causing minor damage. P1 was determined to be driving without auto insurance. P2 was provided with a courtesy report at her request. **H24-00460**

**Missing Person:** On May 29th, 2024, at 3:39 PM Hercules officers were dispatched to the area of Lilac Circle for a report of a missing person. The Reporting Party (RP) called to advise that her mother, 86 year old female subject (SUB) had gone missing around 12:00 PM. RP advised SUB suffers from dementia and occasionally wanders off. Officers conducted an extensive area check for several hours. Officers were not able to locate SUB and she was entered into the Missing and Unidentified Persons System (MUPS) as a missing person at risk. **H24-00461**

**Mental Health Evaluation Hold:** On May 29<sup>th</sup>, 2024, at 4:26 PM, officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Sparrow drive for a suicidal person making threatening and suicidal statements towards his elderly mother. Officers arrived on scene and contacted an initially uncooperative 50 year old male subject (SUB). SUB refused to exit the home and was acting extremely erratic. Officers were able to de-escalate the situation and call SUB out of the home. SUB was ultimately detained without incident and transported to Contra Costa County Regional Medical Center after being determined to be a danger to others and himself. **H24-00462**

**Warrant Arrest:** On May 29, 2024, at approximately 10:09 PM, an Officer conducted a traffic enforcement stop on a 1999 Toyota Sienna. The Officers contacted multiple subjects in the vehicle. The front passenger, 52 year old male of San Jose, was found to have a cite/release warrant issued by Colma PD. The subject was cited and released on scene. **H24-00463**
