Outside Assist: On June 4, 2024, at 3:20 pm, Officer's received an Automated License Plate Reader (ALPR) notification for a gray 2013 KIA.. Oakland PD identified the KIA as being the suspect vehicle in a robbery that occurred in Oakland. At 3:32 pm Officers located the vehicle driving on Pheasant Drive. An investigative stop of the vehicle was conducted, and the vehicle immediately yielded on Sycamore Ave. at Refugio Valley Rd. Oakland PD was contacted and requested HPD Officers identify the vehicle's occupants. The driver was identified as a 21 year old male, of Rodeo. The passengers were identified as 17 year old male, of Pinole, and an 18 year old male, of San Pablo. Upon further investigation, it was determined the vehicle was involved in a carjacking that also occurred in Oakland. Oakland PD responded to Hercules to tow the vehicle for evidence. The occupants were released from detention, at the scene, at the discretion of Oakland PD. **H24-00490**

Recovered Stolen Plates: On June 4, 2024, at 4:28 pm, Officer's received an ALPR notification for a stolen license plate. The license plate was attached to a blue 2022 Toyota Sienna. An Officer located the Toyota in parked in the Creekside parking lot near Dragon Terrace. The Officer contacted the driver of the Toyota who was identified a 28 year old male, of Pinole. The driver stated he recently returned from China. He needed to register his Toyota and his friend helped him with the DMV registration. The friend reportedly then provided the driver with the license plates to put on his vehicle. The license plates were removed from Sienna to be sent back to the DMV. The entry for the plates was removed from the Stolen Vehicle System. **H24-00491**

Mental Health Detention: On June 4, 2024, at 8:50pm, officers contacted a 38 year old male transient in the 800 block of Willow Ave. The subject was dropped off by CHP after an officer found the subject walking on the freeway. When officers attempted to ask the subject where he was trying to go, he stated he was waiting for a spaceship. In addition, the subject appeared to be in poor condition, and could not provide an intelligible response to any further questions. Based on the subject's condition, prior actions and statements, he was determined to be a danger to himself. AMR transported him to the Contra Costa Regional Medical Center. **H24-00492.**

Towed Abandoned Vehicle: On June 5, 2024, at 4:32pm, an officer towed a Dodge Pickup left abandoned in the Hercules Transit Center parking lot. The vehicle has not moved from its position for approximately one month and all previous attempts to contact the Registered Owner were unsuccessful. **H24-00493.**
