Mental health On June 11, 2024 at 12:42 PM officers responded to the 2100 block of Redwood Road for a 17 year old male attempting to hurt himself. Officers spoke to the subject's mother who advised her son wanted to hurt himself and was alone in his bedroom. Officers contacted the juvenile and determined he met the criteria for a Mental Health evaluation. The subject was transported to the Contra Costa Regional Medical Center by AMR. **H24-0514**

Driving Under the Influence (DUI) Collision/Child Endangerment On June 11, 2024, at 4:07pm officers were dispatched to an injury collision at the intersection of San Pablo Avenue and Hercules Avenue. Officers located a black 2015 Land Rover, a Gold 2003 Ford Explorer, and a red 2021 Nissan, at the intersection. It was determined all three vehicles were involved in the collision. There was severe damage to the Land Rover and the Ford Explorer. The Nissan sustained minimal damage. The investigation indicates the Land Rover was the responsible vehicle, and was driven by a 42 year old female from Pinole. The Land Rover was driving southbound on San Pablo Avenue and hit the Explorer, and Nissan, which were stopped at a red light at the intersection. The driver of the Land Rover had her 5 year old son in the front passenger seat. He was not wearing a seatbelt at the time of the collision. The collision caused a serious head injury to the child, and he was transported to Children's Hospital in Oakland. The driver of the Ford was a 57 year old female, of Pinole. She sustained moderate injuries, as a result of the collision, and she was transported to a local hospital. The 55 year old female driver, of the Nissan did not appear to be injured. The driver of the Land Rover did not appear to be injured but displayed objective signs of intoxication. She was given the Standard Field Sobriety Test but refused to submit to a Preliminary Alcohol Screening. The subject was arrested for one count of Felony Child Endangering and two counts of Felony DUI and transported to HPD. Officers obtained the Search Warrant for a blood chemical test. The subject was later transported to the Martinez Detention Facility. **H24-00515/H24-00516**

Warrant Arrest: On June 11, 2024, an officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle on the WB I80 on ramp from willow. After providing several false names and providing someone else's identification, the 49 year old male passenger, was positively identified. He was found to have a non-citable warrant out of Contra Costa County. The

subject was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility where he was booked without incident. **H24-00517.**
