CRIME PREVENTION TIP: Anytime you receive information about winning a contest; a lottery prize; an inheritance from a previously unknown relative; etc.; be very suspicious of a scam. This is particularly true if the information is from a phone call, email, or text. The scammers may want you to prove your identity by having you provide, or verify, personal information (spelling of your name, your date of birth, and or your social security number). The scammers may also ask you to send money to cover taxes, bank fees, etc. They will often want you to provide the money by buying a prepaid credit card and giving the "code" to the scammer. DONOT FALL VICTIM TO SCAMMERS. Be aware and be safe.

<u>Outside Assist:</u> On June 12, 2024, at 5:22 PM officers received a Flock notification for a black Lexus IS 250 which is associated to a case out of San Jose PD. An officer located the vehicle and conducted an investigative stop on Seventh Street and Rodeo Avenue in Rodeo. The occupants contact were not the individuals wanted by San Jose.
