Warrant Arrest / Located Missing Person / Recovered Stolen Vehicle: On June 18, 2024, at 11:13pm, an officer observed a vehicle parked near the air pump at the 76 Gas Station with an unknown adult male filling the tire. The officer spoke with Sheriff's Deputies in the area who believed the Infiniti sedan had a commercial plate attached to the rear. Upon returning to the vehicle, it was determined to be unoccupied. A short time later, the officer noticed a similar looking subject walking onto the EB I80 on ramp from Willow Ave. The officer conducted a pedestrian stop on the 26 year old male, who is Bay Area transient. A record check revealed the subject had two outstanding non-citable warrants out of Solano County and was also listed as a missing person out of Richmond. The subject was taken into custody without incident and later transported to the Martinez Detention Facility. The subject's name was removed from the Missing and Unidentified Persons System. Officers responded back to 76 Gas where a record check on the Infiniti's license plate revealed it belonged to a Chevy pickup. A record check on the VIN revealed it was reported stolen out of Oakland. It was determined the subject was not the driver of the Infiniti. The officer broadcasted the description of the outstanding suspect and area checks were conducted but he was not located. The vehicle was recovered and towed. **H24-545 / H24-546.**
