<u>Mental Health:</u> On June 27,2024 at 8:33 AM officers were dispatched to the Shell station at 3900 San Pablo Avenue for a 31 year old female acting erratically. Officers located the subject running in and out of traffic causing a hazard to herself and others. The subject attempted to flee on foot, but she was detained. <u>Death Investigation:</u> On June 27, 2024, at approximately 5:13 AM, Officers were dispatched to a report of a 78-year-old female reportedly suffering from cardiac arrest. Officers arrived along with Hercules Rodeo Fire. After CPR efforts, the Hercule resident was pronounced deceased. Coroner's Officer was notified. **Case 24-00581** 

<u>Prisoner Transport:</u> On June 28,2024 our Parking Enforcement Officer picked up a 44 year old male who was arrested in Marin County for a warrant out of our City. The subject was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility. **H24-00582** 

<u>Miscellaneous:</u> On June 28,2024 at 1:38 PM officers responded to the 200 block of Bobolink for a family dispute between 42 year old female, and her 16-year-old son. The son reportedly caused major damage to the residence, but his mother elected not to press charges on her son. A case was taken to document the incident. **H24-00583** 

Obstructing/Resisting/Delaying a Peace Officer/Towed Vehicle: On June 28, 2024, at 7:39 PM, an Officer observed a 2012 Hyundai Sonata. The Officer recognized the Sonata as

the same vehicle that fled from dayshift on June 22, 2024, Case H24-00560. The Officer conducted a traffic stop for vehicle code violations. The 26 year old male driver, of Rodeo/Hercules, was contacted. The subject was uncooperative. He was found to have a suspended license. The Officer elected to tow the vehicle per 22651(p) CVC (driving a vehicle on a suspended license). When the officer asked the subject to exit the vehicle, the subject began pulling away from Officers and was non-complaint. The subject was arrested for Obstructing. Resisting, and Delaying an officer, and handcuffed. He was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility. The vehicle was towed from the scene. **Case H24-00584** 

Warrant Arrest x2/Towed Vehicle: On June 28, 2024, an Officer observed a 2008 BMW 535i, with no plates, parked at Home Depot. The vehicle was occupied by two subjects. Officers contacted a 33 year old male. of Sacramento, and 34 year old female, of Vallejo. The 33 male was found to have a No Bail California Department of Corrections Parolee at Large warrant for his arrest. The female was found to have a No Bail warrant issued by Napa for fraud charges.
