Threats and Brandishing a Weapon: On July 2, 2024, at 8:04 am, officers were dispatched to Amber Ct. for a subject who threatened his neighbor and brandished a knife. Officers arrived and contacted the victim who stated his 60 year old male neighbor was in his own driveway, on Amber Ct The suspect yelled at the victim, who was stinking in his own driveway and threatened the victim if he stepped on the suspect's property, Then the suspect pulled out a folding knife. The victim was in sustained fear for his life. There were multiple witnesses as the victim was having work done to his house. The suspect was contacted and arrested for the listed crimes. A search warrant was authored and signed by the judge to search the house for the knife. A knife was located and taken as evidence. The suspect had a Pit Bull who was taken by Animal Control. The house was secured, and the suspect was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility. <u>H24-00597</u>

<u>Driving Under Influence:</u> On July 2, 2024, at 11:29pm, an officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle at the intersection of Turquoise and Crystal Cir. Upon contact, the 33 year old female driver, displayed symptoms of intoxication. The subject was given the Standard Field Sobriety Test. The Preliminary Alcohol Screening device indicated the subject was over the presumptive limit for the purposes of driving. The subject was arrested and transported to HPD for a consensual blood alcohol test. The subject was cite-released, to a responsible party, upon her signed promise to appear. **H24-00598.**

Mental Health Evaluation: On July 2, 2024, at 11:38pm, officers received a request from Richmond PD for a Welfare Check on a possible suicidal subject who was reportedly driving from Richmond to an address in Hercules. Officers responded to the address where they contacted a 22 year old female. The subject was extremely emotional and claimed she wanted to hurt herself. Based on the subject's demeanor and statements, she was determined to be a danger to herself. She was transported to the Contra Costa Regional Medical Center by AMR H24-00599
