Prisoner Transport: On July 15, 2024, at 9:57 am, the Parking Control Officer responded to Santa Rita Jail to pick up 33 year old male, for a felony warrant held by HPD. The warrant was issued for a firearms and drug possession charge. The subject was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility without incident. **H24-00639**

Violation of Court Order: On July 15, 2024, at 10:50pm, officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Wadi Run, for a report of a 27 year old male harassing his mother. Upon arrival, officers could hear the male, upstairs, yelling. Officers contacted the subject. The Officers observed the male appeared to be under the influence, and in close proximity to his mother. The male was detained and brought downstairs. The male started pulling away from officers as he was walked to a patrol vehicle. While at the vehicle, the male beat his own head against the hood of the Police car. Medics were called to evaluate the subject for any possible injuries. AMR arrived on scene and evaluated the subject. He was determined to be uninjured. It was determined the subject was in violation of a valid Restraining Order, which allowed only "peaceful" contact at the residence The subject was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility. He was booked without further incident **H24-00640**.

Vehicle Tampering: On July 16, 2024, at 1:20 pm, an Officer observed an in progress catalytic converter theft in the Safeway parking lot. A 37 year old male, of San Pablo, was observed removing the catalytic converter from a silver 2000 Lexus RX300. The Lexus had been left in the parking lot, on Sunday (07/14/24), due to the vehicle having mechanical issues. As the Officer approached the suspect, he came out from under the Lexus and attempted to walk away from the vehicle. The suspect was detained without incident and later placed under arrest for vehicle tampering. The subject was issued a citation and was released from custody on his signed promise to appear.
