Towed Vehicle: On July 23, 2024, at 1:43 pm, an Officer checked on a vehicle in the Safeway parking lot. The vehicle was a silver 2008 Nissan Altima. The license plate attached to its rear did not belong to the Altima. The VIN, in the vehicle's dashboard, was covered by a piece of paper and not readable. A tow truck responded to the scene to impound the vehicle. Upon the tow company's arrival, access was made into the vehicle for an inventory search, and to confirm the vehicle's VIN number. **(H24-00656)**

Identity Theft: On July 23, 2024, at 1:33 pm, an Officer handled a lobby detail regarding a reported identity theft. The 55 year old male victim, of Hercules, stated an unknown suspect opened a credit card account, without his permission, using his personal information. There has been no financial loss reported. However, the credit card account did appear on his credit report. The victim contacted the bank to cancel the account and was instructed to file a police report by the bank. **(H24-00658)**

Missing Person: On July 23, 2024, at 3:35 pm, an Officer handled a lobby detail regarding a missing juvenile. The reporting party stated her 15-year-old son ran away from home July 22, 2024. The mother stated she knew her son's whereabouts, but she needed a report to provide to Children and Family Services. **(H24-00659)**

Possession of a Controlled Substance: On July 23, 2024, at 4:04 pm, an Officer conducted a traffic stop on a silver Chevy Malibu, in the area of San Pablo Ave at Linus Pauling Dr, for vehicle code violations. The 20 year old male driver, was found to be on searchable probation out of Alameda County. A compliance search was conducted of the subject and the vehicle. A bottle containing suspected Promethazine was located in the subject's backpack. The subject was arrested, cited, issued a court date, and released from the scene. **(H24-00660)**

Possession of Controlled Substance: On July 24, 2024, at 6:15am, officers responded to Shell gas for a report of a reckless driver. a 28 year old male driver was contacted, in his vehicle, and detained.
