## Organized Retail Theft/Felony Theft/Possession of Stolen Property/False

**Impersonation/Conspiracy:** On July 25, 2024, at 8:49 PM, an Officer observed an unoccupied Lexus sedan parked at Safeway. The 25 year old female registered owner, of Richmond, was found to have an outstanding warrant for Robbery, issued by Stockton PD. The Officer observed two female subjects exit Safeway and approach the Lexus. The subjects each had a large tote bag purse with hygiene products overflowing from them. The Officer contacted a 23 year old female, of Richmond. A second adult female initially gave a false name (her sister's). The female was ultimately identified as the Register owner of the Lexus. This subject had a second Felony warrant, for Organized Retail Theft, out of Davis PD. The 23 year old female was found to also have an outstanding Felony warrant issued by Davis PD for Organized Retail Theft and Conspiracy. The subjects were arrested for the warrants. A follow-up investigation at Safeway revealed the two subjects worked in concert and concealed approximately \$1,200 dollars worth of Hygiene products in their tote bag purses. Safeway desired prosecution. The theft, and possession of stolen property charges were added. Both subjects were booked at the Martinez Detention Facility. **Case H24-00670** 

**Prisoner Transport:** On July 26<sup>th</sup>, 2024 at 9:53 AM an officer picked up a 25 year old female on an outstanding Hercules PD arrest warrant. The subject was transported from the Sacramento County jail to the Martinez Detention Facility. <u>H24-00671</u>

**Towed Vehicle:** On July 26, 2024, at 11:34 PM, an Officer conducted a traffic stop on a 1997 Blue Honda Civic. The19 year old male driver, of Fairfield, was found to have no issued driver's license. The Civic was towed and the subject was cited and released. **Case H24-00672** 

<u>Mental Health Evaluation</u>: On July 28, 2024, at 1:48 AM, Officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Kensington Circle for a report of a female feeling suicidal. Officers arrived and contacted the 19 year old female. She was determined to be a danger to herself and was transported to the Contra Costa Regional Medical Center by ambulance. **Case 24-00673** 

**Domestic Violence:** On July 28, 2024, at 8:28pm, Officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Paradise Dr. for a report of a domestic incident. Officers contacted a 37 year old male standing outside his apartment. He stated he had gotten into a verbal dispute with his 34 year old ex-girlfriend. Officers contacted the female, inside her vehicle. The female stated she and the male were inside his apartment, talking. The male told her to leave, and they argued. The investigation indicated the male forced the female to leaveby dragging her out by the hair. The female did not appear to be injured. The male was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility. **H24-00674**
