<u>Supplement to Case 24-00684:</u> On August 2, 2024, at approximately 12:41 AM, an Officer was contacted by a homeowner in Diamond Court. The Homeowner was reporting that it appeared subjects broke back into his home approximately 1 hour ago and it was unknown if they were still inside. Pinole PD and San Pablo PD K9 responded, and a perimeter and entry team were established. The residence was cleared without any suspects being located. The residence was further ransacked and vandalized this time. The homeowner was not aware at the time that subjects had entered. The investigation is ongoing. **H24-00684** 

<u>Towed Vehicle:</u> On August 2, 2024, at 7:38 AM an officer located a vehicle parked in the area of John Muir Pkwy and San Pablo Avenue. The vehicle was a red Pontiac Montana Van and had expired registration for over six months and a day. The vehicle was towed. **H24-00688** 

**Battery:** On August 3, 2024, at approximately 12:17 AM, Officers were dispatched to the 3000 block of N Front Street for a report of a dispute between a repo driver and residents. Officers arrived and contacted the victim (V), 48 year old male of Oakland. V stated he is a repo driver and was attempting to repo an overdue rental, a 2021 Nissan Altima, from this location. V stated he has attempted to repo this Nissan multiple times. V began to attempt to load the vehicle onto the flatbed when 3 males exited a nearby residence and confronted him. One of the males shoved V and then punched him in the face. A younger male entered the Nissan and fled while the other two went back into the residence. V desired prosecution against the subject who punched him. Multiple attempts to contact the residents were made with no success. **H24-00689** 

<u>Warrant Arrest:</u> On August 3, 2024, at approximately 3:51 AM, Officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Paradise for a report of a male heard in the area kicking a door. Officers arrived and located the destroyed front door to a residence. A surround and call-out was conducted. A 30 year old male subject (SUB), of Hercules, exited the residence. SUB was detained and the residence was cleared without any other subjects inside. Contact was made with the homeowner, and she stated SUB does live there and is allowed to be there. The homeowner also did not want a report, or anything done for the damage. SUB was found to have two outstanding warrants for his arrest issued by our agency. SUB was transported to Martinez Detention Facility. Officers contacted property maintenance along with the homeowner being enroute. **H24-00690** 

<u>Residential Burglary:</u> On August 3, 2024, at 7:34 AM officers responded to Diamond Court for a burglary in progress. The victim (V) advised he could see the subjects on a live feed from his surveillance cameras within his home. Officers arrived and set a perimeter while V advised the suspects were still being seen within the home. With assistance from multiple agencies, including a K9 Unit from San Pablo, we made entry into the home and cleared the

residence. The suspects fled prior to our arrival. Public Works arrived on scene to secure the residence. The investigation is ongoing. **H24-00691** 

<u>Miscellaneous Information:</u> On August 3, 2024, at approximately 8:30 PM, Officers were dispatched to a reported attempted robbery near 2525 Bayfront Blvd. The Reporting Party informed dispatch that someone attempted to rob his dog and provided a suspect description and direction of travel. When Officers arrived in the area, they located a subject later identified as a 32 year old male, of Hercules, who matched the description provided. A high-risk pedestrian stop was conducted, and the subject was detained without incident. Upon taking both parties' statements, it was determined that no crime had occurred.
