Warrant Arrest/Transport: On August 27, 2024, at 10:43 am an officer responded to San Francisco County Jail and picked up a 38 year old female for an outstanding Hercules warrant. The subject was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility without incident. **H24-00768**

Outside Assist/ Stolen Vehicle Recovery: On August 27, 2024, at 4:11 pm an Officer was in the area of Victoria Crescent West when he received a Lojack hit of a stolen vehicle. The stolen vehicle was a 2001 Lexus IS 300, that was reported stolen to Vallejo PD. An area check was conducted, and an officer located the vehicle at Rodeo Auto Wreckers, 700 Parker Avenue. The Lexus had been smashed by employees of Rodeo Auto Wreckers. An Officer confirmed the Lexus' VIN with Dispatch and CHP was routed to the scene to take over the investigation. **H24-00769**

Domestic Violence: On August 27, 2024 at 8:46 PM officers responded to the 300 block of Sparrow Drive. The 29 year old male, reporting party advised his 25 year old girlfriend hit him in the eye. The reporting party said the girlfriend was still at the residence with him. Officers arrived and contacted both subjects separately. Based on evidence, and statements, the male subject was arrested for being determined to be the primary aggressor. It was determined the female had taken the male's phone. The male and began to choke the female multiple times. The female struck the male, in the eye, to defend herself. There was an 8-year-old male juvenile present during the altercation. The male was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility. **H24-00770**
