Located on his person, and throughout the vehicle, was approximately 10 pounds of suspected Marijuana; over a quarter pound Brick of suspected Fentanyl; and approximately 5 ounces of suspected Methamphetamine. Each substance had some individually portioned product in small amounts. The subject also had a substantial amount of cash, rubber banded; a scale; and more empty new baggies.
