Coroner's Case: On September 4, 2024, at 2:13 PM officers responded to the Country Run Community pool for an unresponsive male. Officers located a 46 year old male laying on the ground not breathing and unresponsive. Life saving measures were performed by officers, Rodeo-Hercules Fire District, and AMR. The subject was determined to be deceased by paramedics on scene. Officers contacted next of kin, and the coroner responded and took possession of the body for further investigation. **H24-00787**

Voluntary Missing Person: On September 4, 2024, at 3:13 PM officers responded to the 1800 block of Lupine Road and contacted the Reporting Party (RP), 36 year old male. The RP wanted to report his mother, 66 year old female, missing. The missing person (MP) was last seen by her son on Saturday August 24, 2024, at approximately 6:30 PM. At this time, MP is not at risk and is voluntarily missing. MP was entered into the Missing and Unidentified Persons System. **H24-00788**

Warrant Arrest: On September 4, 2024, at approximately 9:34 PM, an Officer conducted a traffic enforcement stop on a Nissan Sentra. The Officer contacted a passenger, 31 year old male of Antioch, in the vehicle. The subject was found to have two outstanding felony warrants issued by San Mateo County; both were citable. The subject was cited and released on scene. **H24-00789**

Towed Vehicle: On September 5, 2024, at approximately 1:58 AM, an Officer checked on a suspicious vehicle at 1375 Willow Ave. The vehicle, a 2006 Buick, was observed parked for multiple days unoccupied.
