Towed Vehicle On September 12, 2024 at 11:19 AM the Parking Enforcement Officer located a black Ford Five-Hundred parked in in the 1500 block of Swallow Way. The vehicle had been previously tagged and was still parked in the same location for over 72 Hours. The Ford was towed. **H24-0815**

Suspended License for Driving Under the Influence (DUI): On September 12, 2024 at 4:03 PM an officer conducted a traffic stop on a Honda Sedan. The 34 year old male driver, of Hercules was found to be on DUI probation and his license was suspended. He was cited and released on scene. **H24-0817**

Miscellaneous Investigation: On September 13, 2024 at 1:07 PM officers responded to Hercules Middle School, at 2000 Refugio Valley Road, for a possible child abuse investigation. The 12 year old child made statements to a teacher about possibly being physically abused. After a full investigation, speaking to the parents of the child, and conducting a welfare check at the residence, officers determined there were no signs of physical abuse. Children and Family Services was contacted which also conducted their own welfare check with no findings of child abuse. **H24-0821**

Mental Health: On September 13, 2024 at 3:32 PM officers responded to the 100 block of Chinquapin Court for a "911 Disconnect". A person could be heard screaming. Officers contacted the residents and family members stated a 75 year old female was having a "psychotic episode". The subject was placed on a mental health hold and transported to a hospital by AMR. **H24-00822**

Occupied Stolen Vehicle: On September 13, 2024, at approximately 8:36 PM, an Officer observed a stolen, 2019 Kia Rio, traveling eastbound in the 800 block of Willow Ave. An hour

prior, Officers had received a Flock camera notification for this vehicle on San Pablo Ave at Victoria Crescent East. The Officer followed the vehicle until covered arrived and a traffic stop was conducted on Canterbury at Bristol. The 19 year old male driver, of Berkeley, was detained. When asked to throw the keys out of the window, the subject threw an iPhone charger out. A juvenile passenger was also detained. The vehicle was confirmed outstanding on today's date by Berkeley PD. The subject was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility; The juvenile was released to a family member at HPD. The vehicle was towed. **Case 24-00823**

Driving Under the Influence: On September 14, 2024, at approximately 12:16 AM, HPD Officers, assigned to the Concord DUI enforcement detail, conducted a traffic stop on a 2001 Honda. Th 30 year old male driver, of Concord. Was given the Standard Field Sobriety Test. The Preliminary Alcohol Screening device indicated the subject was over the presumptive limit for the purposes of driving. The subject was arrested and booked for DUI charges at the Concord Jail. **Case 24-00824**
