Domestic Violence: On September 19, 2024, at 8:36 AM, the Reporting Party/Victim (RP/V) from the 500 block of Athena arrived at HPD to report a physical altercation. RP/V stated she was in bed with her boyfriend, 40 year old male subject (SUB) from Antioch, when they had an argument. RP/V attempted to push SUB out of bed, and SUB grabbed a beer can off the nightstand and smashed it on her head. An Emergency Protective Order was granted and served. SUB denied the allegations and was not willing to meet with officers. **H24-00836**

Theft: On September 19, 2024, at 3:23 PM, the Reporting Party (RP), from the 1000 block of Forest Run came to the station to report the theft of her Tesla's license plate. RP said she had ordered custom license plates from DMV in May 2024 and had not received them. She suspects it was taken from her mailbox. **H24-00837**

Stolen Vehicle: On September 19, 2024, at 3:59 PM an officer responded to the 2000 block of Drake Lane and contacted the Reporting Party/Victim (RP/V). RP/V stated his dark gray Acura TLX was last seen yesterday at 3:00 PM at his residence. Today when he went out to look for his vehicle it was gone. The vehicle was entered into the Stolen Vehicle System. **H24-00838**

Warrant Arrest: On September 20, 2024, at approximately 1:44 AM, an Officer conducted a traffic enforcement stop on a 2013 Infiniti G35. A passenger in the vehicle, 28 year old male of Vallejo, was found to have an outstanding warrant issued by Rohnert Park PD. The warrant was citable. The subject was cited on his promise to appear on scene. **H24-00839**

Theft/Court Order/Probation Violation: On September 20, 2024, at 3:41 PM officers responded to the 100 block of Wadi Run where a 27 year old male subject (SUB) was screaming at family. SUB was detained without incident, and it was determined that he stole electronics from family and sold them. SUB also violated a court order only allowing peaceful contact with his family, and he also violated his probation. SUB was arrested and transported to Martinez Detention Facility. **H24-00840**

Animal Control: On September 20, 2024, at 2:10 PM officers responded to the 100 block of Obsidian Way regarding an injured deer stuck in a backyard. Officers arrived and located a deer which fled into a backyard on Garnet Court. Officers noticed the deer was severely injured, suffering, and had no chance on recovery. Officers euthanized the deer without incident, and Animal Control was contacted. The deer was removed from the residence's backyard. **H24-00841**

Mental Health Evaluation: On September 20, 2024, at approximately 6:49 PM, Officers were dispatched to an unwanted female at Peet's Coffee who was threatening staff and then jumped onto a parked car. Officers arrived and contacted a 31 year old female of Richmond.

The subject was determined to be a danger to herself and others. The subject was transported to Contra Costa Regional Medical Center by AMR. **H24-00842**

Driving Under the Influence (DUI): On September 21, 2024, at approximately 1:26 AM, an Officer assigned to the DUI Suppression in Concord conducted a vehicle stop on a 2005 Infiniti. The 18 year old male driver was given the Standard Field Sobriety Tests. The Preliminary Alcohol Screening test indicated the subject was over the presumptive limit for the purposes of driving. The subject was booked at the Concord Jail. **H24-00843**

Driving Under the Influence: On September 21, 2024, at approximately 3:53 AM, an Officer conducted a traffic enforcement stop on a 2022 Honda CRV. The driver, 43 year old male subject (SUB) of San Francisco, showed objective signs and symptoms of intoxication. The officer also located an open container of alcohol in SUB's center cup holder. SUB was given the Standard Field Sobriety Test; and the Preliminary Alcohol Screening device indicated SUB was over the presumptive limit for the purpose of driving. SUB was taken into custody and his vehicle was towed on scene. SUB was later released to a responsible party at HPD. **H24-00844**

Tamper with Vehicle/Theft: On September 21, 2024, at 8:46 AM an officer responded to the area of Worcester for the theft of tires and tampering of a 2000 green Dodge Caravan. The Reporting Party/Victim said his vehicle was last seen intact yesterday around 3:30 PM. **H24-00846**

Stolen Vehicle: On September 21, 2024, at 9:15 AM an officer responded to the 1300 block of Sycamore Avenue for the report of a 1992 blue Honda Accord being stolen. The Reporting Party stated he parked his vehicle near his residence yesterday at 4:00 PM. He noticed his vehicle was gone at the time of call. **H24-00845**

Vandalism: On September 21, 2024, at 1:12 PM officers responded to the 400 block of Weymouth where the Reporting Party/Victim (RP/V) saw a male break her apartment window through surveillance video. After reviewing the video, it appears a juvenile threw a glass bottle at the window and shattered it. RP/V wishes to press charges if the juvenile is located. **H24-00847**

Found Property: On September 21, 2024, at approximately 8:05 PM, an Officer conducted a traffic enforcement stop on a blue Mazda 3 with a lost/stolen license plate attached that belonged to a 2018 Toyota Rav4. The license plate was reported stolen out of Oakland PD in June of 2024. The Officer learned that the driver, 31 year old male Oakland, did not know the plate was on his vehicle and suspected his license plate was stolen from his home in San Leandro or Oakland where he works. The Officer recovered the one stolen license plate, and the driver would contact San Leandro PD for a license plate report. **H24-00848**

Driving Under the Influence/Child Endangerment/Probation Violation: On September 21, 2024, at approximately 9:30 PM, an Officer observed a 2018 Honda CRV that was swerving and stopping in lanes of traffic in the 900 block of Willow Ave. A traffic enforcement stop was conducted and a 25 year old female subject (SUB), of Concord, was contacted. SUB's 6-year-old daughter was in the backseat of the vehicle. In the center console was an open container of alcohol. SUB showed objective signs and symptoms of intoxication. SUB also had a suspended license for DUI and was on DUI probation out of Contra Costa. The Standard Field Sobriety Tests were conducted. The Preliminary Alcohol Screening test indicated the subject was over the presumptive limit for the purposes of driving. SUB was taken into custody for various charges. SUB's mother came and picked up the 6-year old

child on scene. The Honda was towed. Children & Family Services were contacted regarding the child endangerment. **H24-00849**

Mental Health Evaluation: On September 21, 2024, at approximately 10:28 PM, Officers responded to the 300 block of N Wildwood for a disturbance. Officers contacted a 53 year old female and determined she was a danger to herself. The subject was transported to the Contra Costa Regional Medical Center by AMR. **H24-00850**

Miscellaneous Information: On September 21, 2024, at approximately 10:46 PM, Officers were dispatched to the 2000 block of Central Street for a 911 disconnect from a cellphone related to a 43 year old female subject (SUB 1). Officers arrived and contacted SUB 1. SUB 1 stated her ex, 48 year old male subject (SUB 2), had entered her home, uninvited, and yelled at her while she was in her bed and then fled the residence. It was unconfirmed if SUB 2 had entered her home. **H24-00851**

Outside Assist: On August 19, 2024, San Pablo PD requested Hercules PD assist with a welfare check on a 45 year old female subject (SUB 1) of Hercules. SUB 1's ex-husband, 47 year old male subject (SUB 2) of San Pablo, requested the welfare check. SUB 1 was fine and it was determined that SUB 2 has mental health issues. SUB 2 was ultimately placed on a mental health evaluation hold. **H24-00852**

Mental Health Evaluation Hold/Resisting an Officer/Battery on a Peace Officer: On September 22, 2024, at 9:25 AM, Officers were dispatched to the 1200 block of Turquoise Drive for a welfare check requested by the Contra Costa County Sheriff Office (CCCSO). Officers responded to the address and contacted a 27 year old male subject (SUB). During the contact, it was discovered that SUB had broken the home's downstairs glass window. In addition, SUB was making erratic statements and was determined to be a danger to himself and others. As Officers went to detain SUB, SUB began actively resisting Officers and was assisted to the ground. While on the ground, SUB continued to resist, which included SUB punching an Officer on their face. Officers were able to safely detain SUB in handcuffs. However, when Officer's tried to assist SUB from the ground to bring him to a patrol vehicle, SUB again began resisting and was again assisted to the ground. AMR arrived on scene and transported SUB to the Contra Costa Regional Medical Center for a mental health evaluation hold. **H24-00853**
